

Guidelines and Evaluation Norms for SPECIFIC COURSES-UG-PG & Int. programs (Industrial Training / Internship Training / Field Visit / Instrumental Training / Summer Training)

Industrial Training / Internship / Training (UG & PG)

The following are the guidelines & evaluation norms of the above courses for the UG & PG programs other than B. Voc. and Integrated B.Sc. – M.Sc. Programs: - HoD may nominate a coordinator for each of the following:

UG Programs

(a) Industrial Training – 40:60 Model

- Continuation Evaluation (by trainer) – 40 marks
- Course end Evaluation (by department) – 60 marks
- Total – 100 marks**
